



ONE SHEET OF DIFFERENT COLOR PAPER FOR THE TRUNK.



1. CUT GREEN PAPER INTO A SQUARE.




2. FOLD THE EXTRA PAPER INTO FOUR EQUAL DIVISIONS.







3. FOLD EACH SECTION IN HALF TO GET 8 DIVISIONS.




4. GET ANOTHER SHEET OF GREEN PAPER. USE THE EXTRA PAPER AS A GUIDE TO OBTAIN 7 SQUARES OF DECREASING SIZE.




5. EACH SQUARE IS 1/8th SMALLER THAN THE PREVIOUS SQUARE.





8. TWO-COLORED PAPER IS SHOWN FOR CLARITY BUT DOUBLE-SIDED-GREEN PAPER IS RECOMMENDED.



P. REPEAT STEPS 7 and 8 ON THE 3 REMAINING FLAPS:


11. INSERT FINGER: OPEN AND FLATTEN SIDES.




12. ROTATE SO THE TIPS POINT DOWN.




13. PUSH IN (SINK) THE CENTRAL VERTEX.




14. SINK THE INNER CREASES FOR APPROX HALF THE DISTANCE FROM a TO b.




15. ONE UNIT COMPLETED. IT CAN ALSO BE A FLOWER.




16. JOIN A SECOND UNIT IN STAGGERED FORMATION:




17. TOP VIEW OF TWO JOINED UNITS:




18· JOIN THE 7 UNITS, • THE TOP UNIT IS SMALLEST:







20. LIFT THE FRONT, BOTTOM VERTEX.
